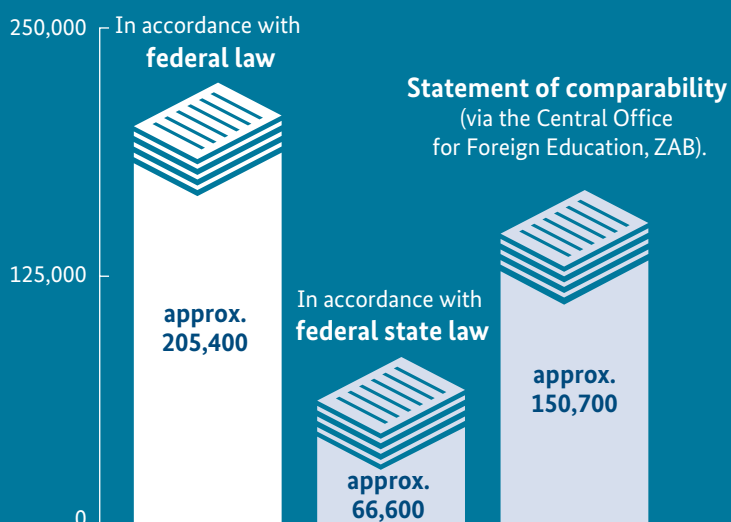
Applications by countries of training 2012 bis 2020

- über 5,000 applications



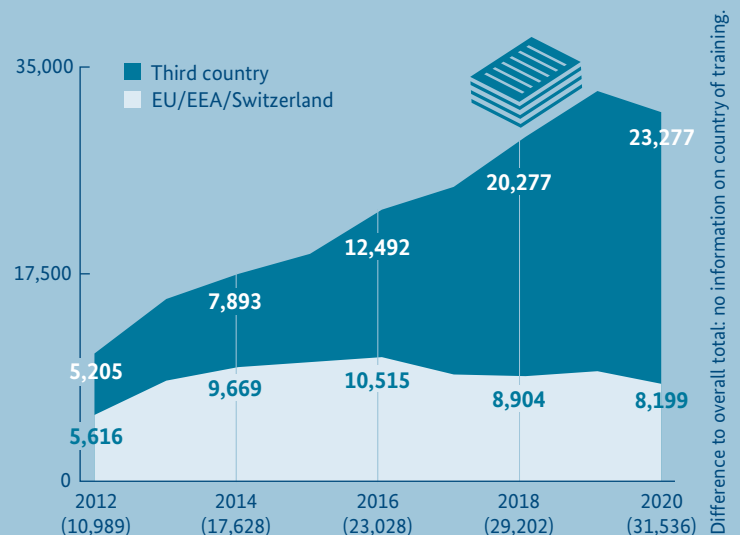
Recognition in accordance with federal law/federal state law and statement of comparability

Around 422,700 applications 2012–2020



A recognition procedure is conducted in accordance with federal or federal state law depending on the profession. A ZAB statement of comparability may also be carried out for non-regulated higher education qualifications.

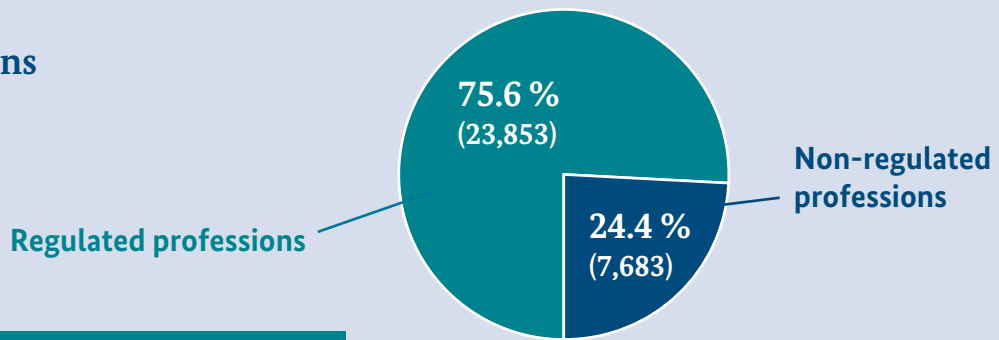
Applications in accordance with federal law 2012–2020 – by countries of training (cat.)



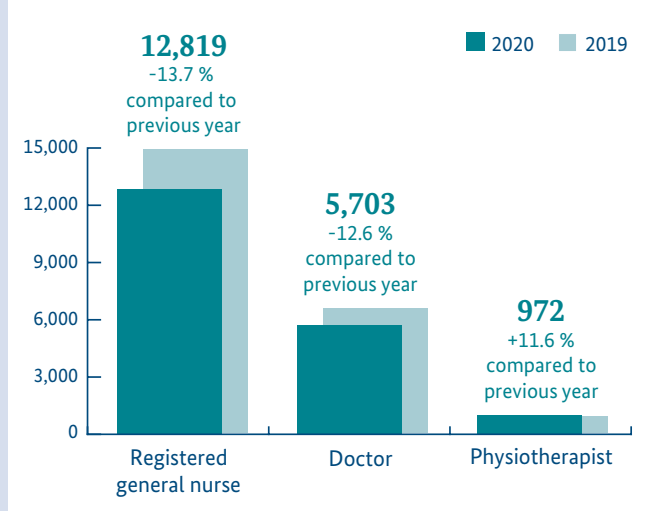
Difference to overall total: no information on country of training.



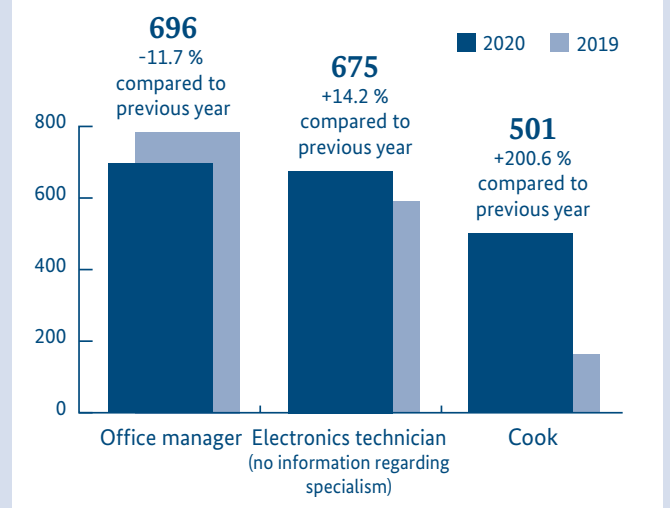

Professions with most applications – non-regulated

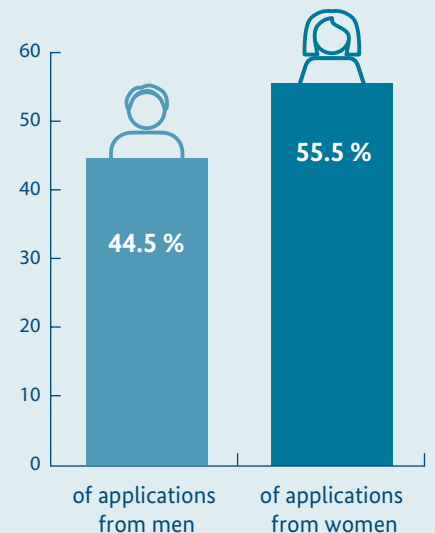


Around **74 percent** of all applications made in 2020 were in a medical healthcare profession.



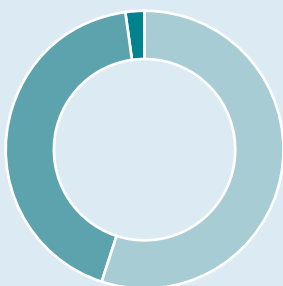
Almost **35 percent** of all applications made in 2020 were submitted from abroad.

Women submitted more applications for recognition in 2020 than men.



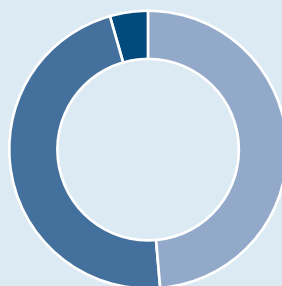
36,696 recognition procedures in 2020 in which a decision was reached

29,889 notices regarding regulated professions



- 55.0 % full equivalence
- 42.8 % resulted in a notice "imposing" a compensation measur
- 2.2 % negative

6,807 notices regarding non-regulated professions



- 48.8 % full equivalence
- 46.9 % partial equivalence
- 4.3 % negative
