

Applications by countries of training **2012 bis 2021**




Recognition in accordance with federal law/federal state law and statement of comparability

Around 500,000 applications 2012-2021



A recognition procedure is conducted in accordance with federal or federal state law depending on the profession. A ZAB statement of comparability may also be carried out for non-regulated higher education qualifications.

Applications in accordance with federal law 2012–2021 – by countries of training (cat.)






Around **140,000** fully recognised qualifications 2012 to 2021






73 percent of all applications made in 2021 were in a medical healthcare profession.




41 percent of all applications made in 2021 were submitted from abroad.
