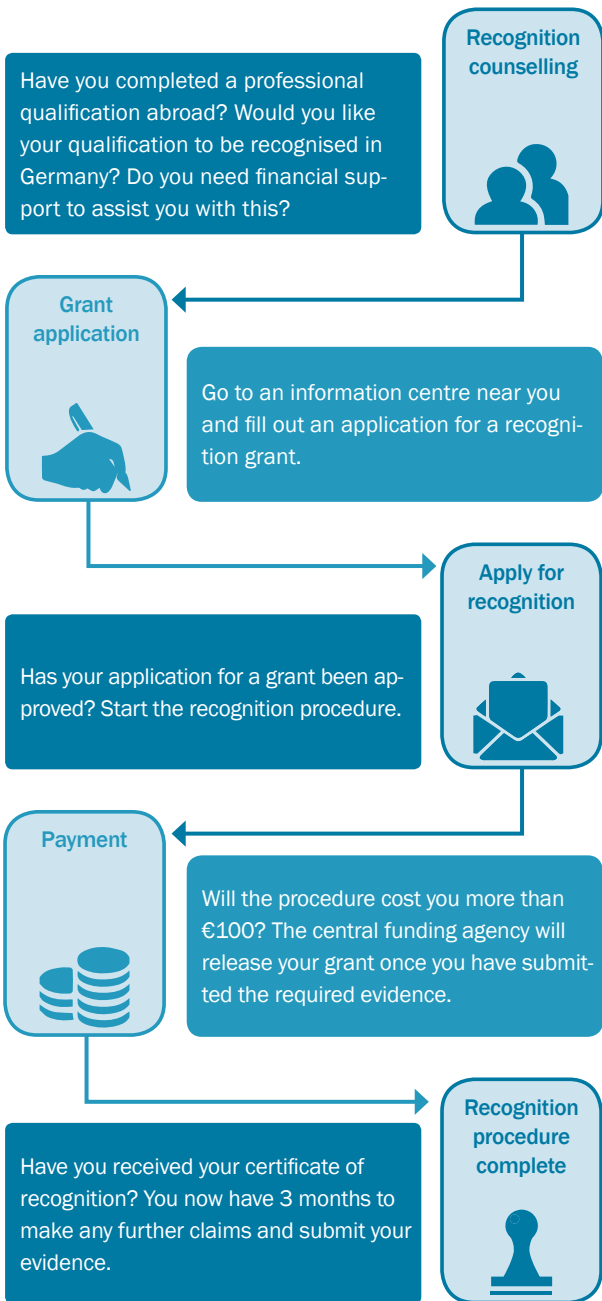


Your path to a grant



The recognition grant...

... is for people who

- have completed a qualification abroad
- want this qualification to be recognised in Germany
- have lived in Germany for at least 3 months
- have an income of less than €26,000 (single people) or €40,000 (married/in a civil partnership)
- will not receive any reimbursement of costs for the recognition procedure from the Federal Employment Agency, Jobcenter or the corresponding funding programmes of the Federal States

... covers the costs of

- fees and transport associated with the recognition procedure
- translation and certification of certificates, qualifications and reports
- obtaining any necessary evidence
- qualification analysis

... up to the value of €600.

Applications can be submitted through an IQ information centre or a chamber (see reverse).

Applicants are not **automatically entitled** to a grant.
